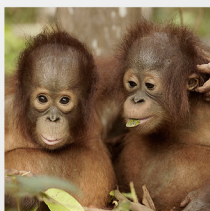
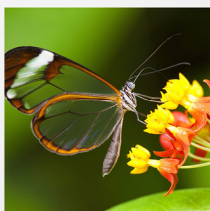
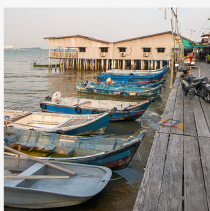
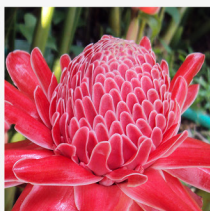
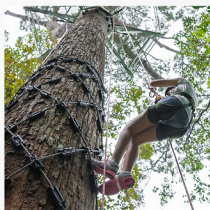


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Round Penang Island



Touring around Penang Island, the “Pearl of the Orient” from its sandy shores to quaint countryside. Stops include an idyllic fishing village, a **cottage industry** to witness the traditional handicraft of Batik painting, the **countryside** for introduction of tropical spices like clove and nutmeg, local fruits in season and try rubber tapping. Photo-stop at a typical **Malay village**, admire the street arts in the small town of Balik Pulau and visit the legendary **Snake Temple**, where Pit Vipers adorn the altars. Tour completes after covering approximately 80-kilometre of different routes and scenery.

Departure: Daily 0900 hours | Duration: 3.5 hours

Penang City Tour



Visit **Chew Jetty*** – the early Chinese migrant settlement in Penang, admire the intricate stone carvings and woodworks of the **Khoo Kongsi** (Chinese Clan House), drive through the colourful **Little India** and the bustling Chinatown. Visit Wat Chaiyamangalaram to see one of Asia’s largest **Reclining Buddha**. Quick stop at Coffee Tree for sampling of local white coffee and Royal Selangor Pewter to learn and appreciate the Malaysian pewter arts. **Additional folklore show only available in afternoon private tour.*

Departure: Daily 0900 / 1400 hours | Duration: 3.5 hours

George Town Heritage Tour



Explore the amazing UNESCO World Heritage Sites in George Town. Photo stop at **Fort Cornwallis**, Penang's most prominent historical fortress. Visit the **Peranakan Mansion** which houses priceless antique collection and artifacts, showcasing an assimilation of cultures between the Malays and the early Chinese settlers. Next stop is the **Cheong Fatt Tze - The Blue Mansion**, an award winner of Asia Pacific Heritage building.

Street Arts of George Town



Travel to inner George Town for an exploratory **walking tour** in search of the unique **murals or wall paintings** mimicking the life in the city. Many have become enamoured of the newly transformed streetscape of George Town. Discover the **wrought-iron caricatures** with anecdotal descriptions of the streets that they adorn. Blending humour and historical facts, sufficient time will be given for photo-shooting.

Street of Harmony (Walking Tour)



Where else in the world can you find a street lined with so many places of worship of different faith, all within a perimeter of one kilometre. The walking tour begins from **St. George's Church**, oldest in Malaysia, to Taoist **Goddess of Mercy Temple** which survived the last two world wars. Across the street is Little India with its colourful **Sri Mahamariamman Temple** decorated with 40 statuettes of Hindu Gods. Further down is **Khoo Kongsi**, a Chinese ancestral clan house cum museum. Then view the nearby **Kapitan Keling Mosque**, the first Arab-Indian Muslim mosque built in Penang.

Departure: Daily 0900 hours | Duration: 3 hours

Traditional Trades and Culture (with Lunch)



Penang is among very few places in this region where traditional trades and culture still exist and being appreciated. This tour will cover the famous **Chowrasta wet market** in George Town where grocery and livestock are traded by the roadsides. At a nearby alley, admire the art of **joss-stick making**, some with intricate dragon motif. Proceed to "**Kuih Culture**" centre where handcrafted Malay cakes are produced, using traditional methods and ingredients. Opportunity to experience the passion and dedication required in handcrafting every single piece of Kuih. Enjoy lunch with kuih as dessert.

Departure: Daily 0830 hours | Duration: 5 hours

George Town by Night (with Food Tasting)



George Town comes alive at night as the gourmet paradise of the East. A slow drive into the city takes you pass some of the landmarks and historical buildings of the colonial era. Pass Little India and part of China Town before the culinary experience of food tasting at a local Street Food Centre. Try the famous **Penang dishes** like Laksa, Char Koay Teow, Rojak etc. After food tasting, have a feel of the old town ambience through a short and relaxing trishaw ride in the centre of George Town.

Departure: Daily 1900 hours | Duration: 3 hours

Dinner @ The Top + Skywalk



Experience a unique and memorable evening at **The Top** in Komtar - the tallest building in Penang and Northern Malaysia. Dinner will be at the exquisite Coco Cabana restaurant at the 68th floor. Before dinner you are recommended to explore the **Window of The Top**, an outdoor open deck at the same floor with unbridled 360° stunning bird's eye views of Penang. The star attraction there is the **Rainbow Skywalk** - a thrilling walk-on-air experience on a glass walkway suspended 249-metre above ground.

Departure: Daily 1830 hours | Duration: 3 hours

Penang Grand Tour (with Lunch)



This tour covers the main highlights of Penang Island. It includes **Chew Jetty** – the early Chinese migrant settlement in Penang, the intricate stone carvings and woodworks of the **Khoo Kongsi** (Clan House), the colourful **Little India**, the iconic 720-metre high **Penang Hill** by funicular train and the **Kek Lok Si** – Southeast Asia's largest Buddhist temple with its 30-metre high statue of the Goddess of Mercy. Lunch en-route at a local restaurant, optional stops include Coffee Tree and Royal Selangor Pewter.

Departure: Daily 0900 hours | Duration: 7 hours

Penang Hill and Temple



Ascend **Penang Hill**, 720-metre above sea level by means of funicular train. Enjoy the bird's eye view (usually clearer in the afternoon) of George Town and feel the cool and refreshing air at the summit. Another highlight is **Kek Lok Si**, Southeast Asia's largest Buddhist temple. Marvel at the 30-metre high statue of the Goddess of Mercy, the 7-tier 'Thousand-Buddha Pagoda' and the 'Pond of Longevity'.

Departure: Daily 0900 / 1400 hours | Duration: 4 hours

Habitat Nature Walk (with Lunch)



Ascend the 720-metre high Penang Hill by funicular train to the summit. Visit **The Habitat** – a newly opened 1.6 km nature trail conserved to be the most complete, exciting and educational Malaysian rainforest experience. See the flora and fauna along the trail, appreciate the specialty gardens, and enjoy the fantastic views from the 230-metre long **Canopy Walk** and the **Tree Top Walk** which is the highest viewing platform of Penang. *Note: Participation in other activities such as zip-lining and abseiling will be at extra cost.*

Departure: Daily 0900 hours | Duration: 5 hours

Sunset Walk at Penang Hill + Dinner



Catch the beautiful sunset at Penang Hill. First by taking a stroll through the rainforest trails of The Habitat to **Curtis Crest Tree Top Walk** – the highest point of Penang with unobstructed sunset view over the hill. After refreshment, night walk, amidst the sound of insects and wildlife, back to the entrance of The Habitat. Return journey or take dinner option at the colonial style David Brown's Restaurant.

Departure: Daily 1700 hours | Duration: 4 hours

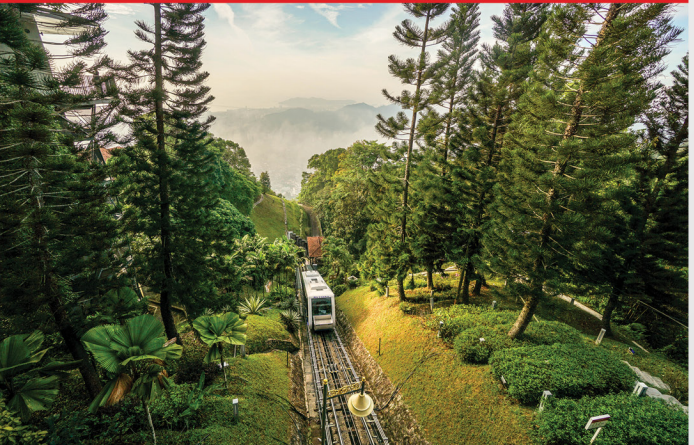
High Tea @ Penang Hill



Experience the unique **funicular train ride** to Penang Hill, 720-metre above sea level. At the summit, appreciate the exhilarating bird's eye view from the cosy David Brown Restaurant, where you get to enjoy **English High Tea** in the cool weather. Take a stroll at the summit before descending.

Departure: Daily 1500 hours | Duration: 3 hours

Dinner @ Penang Hill



A rare experience to dine at Colonial **Penang Hill**, Malaysia's first hill station accessible by the unique funicular railway system. Take a stroll at the summit, feel the cool and refreshing air before enjoying a sumptuous set dinner at the cosy David Brown's Restaurant, with the bird's eye night view of George Town, Penang Bridge and part of the mainland in sight.

Departure: Daily 1830 hours | Duration: 3 hours

Orang Utan and Charcoal Factory (with Lunch)



Travel to Bukit Merah via the 25 km long Penang second bridge, to see and observe the natural habitat of **Orang Utans** living in a small island. These primates are orphans undergoing rehabilitation for future release into the wild. They are friendly to visitors who are separated by a large cage tunnel which makes it appear as if the humans are under captivity while they roam freely on the island. Stop for lunch, and on the way back pass the Taiping Lake Gardens and visit the nearby **charcoal factory** to witness the interesting process of transforming mangrove wood into charcoal.

Departure: Daily 0900 hours | Duration: 6 hours

Tropical Fruit Farm (with Fruit Tasting)



Visit Penang's only **Tropical Fruit Farm** which is ideally located on a hill slope in Teluk Bahang and overlooking the Indian Ocean. Take a guided farm tour and learn about 140 species of local and regional tropical fruits. Opportunity to taste the various tropical fruits in season.

Departure: Daily 0900 / 1400 hours | Duration: 3 hours

Spice Garden and Entopia



The **Tropical Spice Garden** is planted with some 500 spices of tropical spice and herbs. See for yourselves the produce which frequently adorn our kitchen top by taking a guided tour of the garden. The next unique attraction is **Entopia** or Penang Butterfly Farm which brings you the best of insect world seen in harmony with nature. Discover the mystery of the reproduction processes of not only butterfly but dragon fly, firefly, beetles and other small living things, with technology aided interpretation.

Departure: Daily 0900 hours | Duration: 4 hours

Discovery Tour of Entopia



Entopia - the Penang Butterfly Farm where the world of insect is seen in harmony with nature, is divided into 2 parts - the Natureland which is a living vivarium where live butterflies, dragon flies, stick insects, reptiles and etc... are seen in its natural habitat and surroundings, and the Cocoon which covers indoor nature activities and exhibition such as the reproduction process of insects including the firefly and beetles with technology guided interpretation. Scheduled live insect show is included, but refreshments at its Tapestry Café will be at own expense.

Departure: Daily 0900 / 1400 hours | Duration: 3.5 hours

Penang National Park



The smallest national park in Malaysia offers visitors an opportunity to experience many natural facets and habitats. An array of flora and fauna greets visitors along the trails of the tropical rainforest. Apart from monkeys and monitor lizards, migratory birds are frequently sighted at the mangrove swamps. This excursion includes a 2-hour soft jungle trek from Teluk Bahang to Monkey Beach and a return boat journey of 20-minute. Refreshment included.

Departure: Daily 0830 hours | Duration: 4 hours

War Museum and Colonial Museum



This tour combines the only two private historical museums on the island. **Penang War Museum**, built in the 1930's by the British army to protect the island against the enemy, was constructed over 20 acres of land, complete with underground tunnels, bunkers, logistic centre, cannon firing bays, sleeping quarters, cook house and medical infirmary. Next is the **Colonial Penang Museum** which depicts the exquisite lifestyle of the British Administrators and the wealthy merchants of old Penang. Appreciate the collection of intricate art and furniture of the colonial era.

Departure: Daily 0900 hours | Duration: 4 hours

Local Handicrafts Lesson



Pewter is made of 97% tin plus antimony and copper. Here is a chance for you to experience making a pewterware in the **School of Hard Knocks** at Royal Selangor Pewter. Bring home your own hand-made pewter after that. Another interesting hands-on experience is to learn the art of '**hand-drawn**' Batik and create own hand-painted handkerchief using wax and dyes - to take home as a souvenir.

Malaysian Cooking Tour (with Lunch)



This unique experience begins by visiting a wet market, just like most locals do, to check out the fresh ingredients for cooking. After that proceed to the cooking school located in Tropical Spice Garden - the only one in this region and planted with over 500 species of tropical spice plants and trees. Tour the garden before the **cooking demonstration** will be conducted by award-winning chef, in the kitchen overlooking the stunning view of Teluk Bahang Bay. Dishes of the day varies from Nyonya, Malay, Indian and Street Food, all of Malaysian origin or influence. Enjoy the food you helped cooked afterwards.

Departure: Daily 0800 hours | Duration: 5 hours

Pulau Payar Marine Park Excursion (with Lunch)



Approximately 1.5-hour high-speed boat ride away is **Pulau Payar**, the only Marine Park off the West Coast of Peninsular Malaysia. The crystal clear water is reputed to support a multitude of colourful marine life and large species of corals and is ideal for snorkelling. Scuba diving can be arranged at additional cost. Buffet lunch is served at the covered platform. Facilities include an underwater observatory and snorkelling set. Resort dive is optional.

Departure: Daily 0720 hours | Duration: 8 hours

Monkey Beach Excursion (with Lunch)



Take a 30-minute boat ride to an uninhabited white sandy beach fringed with coconut trees and frequented by monkeys from the nearby jungle. Enjoy **the sun, the sea and BBQ lunch** by the beach. For those who love fishing, you can try your luck with the equipment provided.

Departure: Daily 1000 hours | Duration: 5 hours

Penang Street Food Tasting (with Lunch)



Visit the famous street food corners of Penang located in Lorong Selamat, Penang Road and its surrounding areas. Taste the internationally renowned dishes like Laksa, Char Koay Teow, Hokkien Mee, Ice Kacang etc. Our guide will introduce the dishes and do the ordering. Drinks at own expense. Some queuing or waiting is expected but is worth the while - according to those who had experienced it.

Head over to Waterplay and slide down the Banana Flip – a near-vertical 11-metre slide which curves upwards into the air, sending you airborne before the dip. Don't forget to ride down some of the longest raft slides in Malaysia. One-way transfer included. Lunch at own expense.
